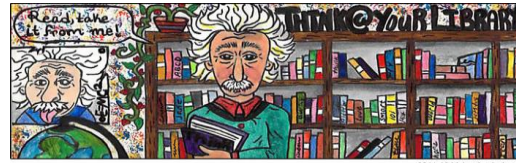

“Look what I discovered at my SCHOOL LIBRARY!” Bookmark Contest Rules

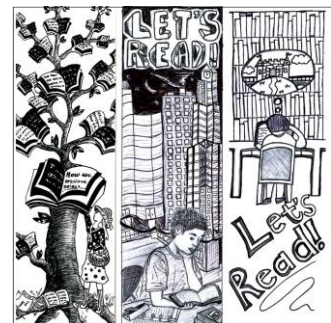
FOR ALL DIVISIONS:

Before you begin, check these rules:
